#### **IPNA-ESPN Master for Junior Classes**

IPNA - ESPN Master for Junior Classes 2020 will be held online on September 19-20, 2020. With this course, we will initiate the Junior Classes Third Cycle and the program will review latest updates on antenatal hydronephrosis, CAKUT, UTI and VUR, voiding dysfunction, fluid and electrolytes management, renal tubular acidosis, Alport syndrome and thin membrane disease, podocytopathies and ciliopathies, ADPKD and ARPKD, renal involvement in metabolic diseases and mitochondrial cytopathies. This year, and concerning the present context, we will also have a very special lecture "COVID-19: special focus on the kidney".

# Call for ESPN congress in 2022, 2023

ESPN 2022 will take place in Ljubljana.

For ESPN 2023 there are two candidates: Vilnius and St. Petersburg. Applications will be voted either in General Assembly or by electronic system in 2021.

#### **Council member election**

In September 2020, five council members (Ana Teixeira (Portugal), Kjell Tullus (United Kingdom), Marina Vivarelli (Italy), Olivia Boyer (France), Sevcan A. Bakkaloglu Ezgu (Turkey)) will finish their 3 year terms.

We thus have five vacant positions this year; all active ESPN members can choose up to 5 persons from the candidates.

Electronic voting will be open from August 10 to September 18 (5 pm, CET), 2020.

If more than one candidate from the same country applies in the same round, only one can be elected. This will be the candidate with the highest number of votes.

The result will be announced at the General Assembly.

#### **ESPN Research Grants**

The aim is to stimulate collaboration between Pediatric Nephrologists in Europe and beyond and to promote clinical or basic science projects pertinent to children with renal disorders.

Research grant submission for 2020 closed May 31, 2020.

Applications are under review the results will be announced at the General Assembly

Project leaders must acknowledge the support of ESPN in any publication or presentation resulting from their work. They may be asked to present their results at the ESPN congresses or ESPN teaching activities.
