ESPN Virtual meeting, 18th September 2020

Due to the COVID-19 pandemic, ESPN organised a one-day virtual meeting with focus on cystinosis, oxalosis and distal RTA. The meeting was very successful with 8 well-known speakers presenting and 502 people having registered.

IPNA-ESPN Master for Junior Classes 2020, 19-20th September 2020

The IPNA-ESPN educational program keeps running on a 3-year basis. In 2020 due to the COVID-19 pandemic the courses were delivered virtually with much success. There were 12 lectures and 1 Upto-Date lecture on COVID-19 with special focus on the kidney. The attendance was great: 150 confirmed attendees and 40 nationalities from all over the world. Among these attendees, 30 students have completed their IPNA-ESPN Master. We congratulate them all for completing the 3-year course successfully.

As a reminder, this IPNA-ESPN educational program is especially dedicated to Paediatric residents, Paediatricians with special interest in Paediatric Nephrology, fellows in Paediatric Nephrology and young Paediatric Nephrologists. The whole program includes three meetings in three consecutive years, and the full attendance will allow the achievement of the IPNA-ESPN Master. ESPN Education Committee

Our Education committee continues to work together for the Harmonization of Paediatric Nephrology Training in Europe and the European Paediatric Nephrology certification. In November 2021, it was the first year of our Board Examination in Paediatric Nephrology. We had 112 participants from 32 countries. It was a very successful overall experience as 83 of our candidates passed their exams. The colleague for scoring the highest among all participants will be announced and receive an award for the excellent performance.

Fellow of European Society for Paediatric Nephrology (FESPN)

The Board examination will continue on a yearly basis.

In the context of having senior/qualified colleagues in Paediatric Nephrology and after introducing our Board Examination, we are introducing for the first time a category called Fellow of the European Society for Paediatric Nephrology (FESPN). To apply for this Fellowship, applicants must meet four out of six requirements and be ESPN-members for the last 5 years.

The 6 set requirements include having ESPN or National Activity, the Board Certification of Paediatric Nephrology, specific number of CME credits, grant support/funding, publications and teaching experience. For more details, please check this out at our website.

ESPN/IPNA future congresses & Call for ESPN Congress in 2023

- ESPN 2021 will take place in Amsterdam, the Netherlands, on the 16-18th September, depending on the status of the COVID-19 pandemic. Should regulations prohibit a full faceto-face meeting, a hybrid meeting will take place at the same date, with a limited number of attendees in Amsterdam, but with full online live coverage and interaction from anywhere in the world. The final decision on the format of the meeting will be taken in May 2021. More information, including the preliminary program and important dates for abstract submission, will be available in January 2021 at ESPN 2021 congress website.
- IPNA will hold a virtual workshop on Evidence-based Clinical Management in Pediatric Nephrology on March 28-31, 2021. The workshop is dedicated to guideline methodology, distribution and implementation. There will be free registration that will open on January 4th. (https://acpn2020.com).

- As a reminder, IPNA congress will be held in Calgary, Canada in 2022, however we have decided to hold an ESPN congress also during the year that we do have an IPNA meeting.
- ESPN 2022 will take place in Ljubljana, Slovenia.
- ESPN 2023: We have 2 candidates (Vilnius, Lithuania and St.Petersburg, Russia). The final decision will be made during ESPN 2021.
