Our study on Immune competence in nephrotic syndrome is ongoing, we are still recruiting patients and performing analysis on PBMC, both by assessing B and T cell subpopulations and specific memory B cell clones anti-HepB and tetanus and circulating total and specific immunoglobulin levels. Based on the results that we collected on children at disease onset and age-matched controls, we submitted this month a paper to Frontiers in Immunology:
