

1. Established ESPN and/or National Activity within Paediatric Nephrology

Serve either in ESPN or in National Societies, as a:

1. Council member
2. Committee member or part of a Working Group
3. Reviewer for ESPN abstract submissions

2. Board Certification in Paediatric Nephrology

Please submit a photocopy of the Certification of Accreditation in Pediatric Nephrology issued by the responsible national authority or submit an equivalent credential (from your hospital, university or national society)

3. Continuing Medical Education (CME) Credits

Complete a total of at least 70 hours during the last two years of AMA PRA Category 1 CME credits.

4. Grant Support/Funding

Receive peer-reviewed, extramural support within the past five years from a federal entity or non-profit organization

5. Publication records

Publish at least 10 articles in peer-reviewed journals or in the five last years.

6. Teaching

Teach at least 30 hours in a local, state, national or international institution in nephrology during the past two years (please submit one confirmation letter from your hospital, university or national society)
