World Kidney Day 2021







We are glad to announce that ESPN is increasing the amount of money dedicated to research grants this year. Our **research grants** will cover up to 80.000 euros and they will be divided in three categories:


- 1) general grants (application should be supported by an ESPN WG),
- 2) WG grants and
- 3) Young Investigator Award grants (for our young members aged up to 35 years old).

Please bear in mind that unsuccessful candidates from previous years may re-apply but they need to declare previous submissions on the application form and itemize how the revised application has addressed previous reviewers' comments.

Here, we would like to recall to our members that ESPN is offering **training grants** for their young members in order to benefit from clinical attachments in large ESPN training centres within Europe. The total amount of each grant will be up to 3000 for a period of 6 months spent in another centre.
