

SOP for Honorary member

ESPN Honorary Members are members of the Society that have made outstanding contributions to Paediatric Nephrology and are generally retired. Candidates must be proposed to the ESPN President by active ESPN members using the appropriate application form. Applications must include a letter of support and the CV of the candidate.

The ESPN Council uses an established scoring system to select candidates by secret vote. Candidates must be elected by at least two-third of the Council. No more than one Honorary Member per country and no more than two Honorary Members can be nominated each year. They are celebrated at the annual ESPN congress. In the year of their nomination, Honorary Members will be invited to the ESPN congress (free travel, free accommodation, and free registration). As part of their honorary membership status, Honorary Members do not need to pay the annual membership fee but cannot be elected to any ESPN official position and are non-voting members of the Society.
