1) JNR/liaison persons:

- National Presidents supportive of this initiative
- Good to include all people with 10 years of experience in Paed Nephrology however we have to do this in a practical way and easily identifiable --> maybe check with each country what would be their age cut-off limit within 10 years of Paed Nephrology training and use the upper limit among their answers (in order to be as much inclusive as possible)? to be studied further by YPNN
- Ask the JNRs/liaison people to get in touch with their National Presidents regularly for a good communication/support/collaboration

2) Participation of YPNN in national meetings

Aim of the program is to disseminate the ESPN and YPNN activities in the different countries

Every year 3-4 national meetings will be selected, based on a voluntary proposal by the organizers of the meeting.

An YPNN booth will be install at each meeting, with an YPNN present at the booth. Some ad-hoc flyers will be prepared

The junior national representative of the specific country will help in the organization. If possible, a talk about the YPNN activity will be given.

The meeting organizers will have the possibility to take advantage of the presence of YPNN members for proposing them a talk on a specific topic, if consistent with the scientific program of the meeting (not an obligation)

The first meetings, for 2023, will be:

- the Portuguese & Spanish Joint Congress of Paediatric Nephrology, May 2023
- the Hungarian Pediatric Nephrology meeting, October 2023
- the French Congress of Paediatric Nephrology, November 2023
- the **Belgian** Pediatric Nephrology meeting, December 2023

The success of program will be evaluated after the first year"
