The European Society for Pediatric Nephrology (ESPN) and The Pediatric Nephrology Research Consortium (PNRC) have created a joint research program to fund researchers from each organization to research shared projects.

The goal of a joint research program is to promote greater partnership and collegiality between Pediatric Nephrologists in Europe and North America in order to improve the care of children with kidney disease.

The ESPN-PNRC Joint Research Program will fund up to three \$10,000 awards in 2023. One award will be for Clinical/ Translational Research, and the second will be for Basic Science/ Translational Research. The award period to complete the proposed project will be one year (maximum up to two years). We encourage applications from early career researchers. 
